America's Promise grantees, with assistance from their Technical (TA) Assistance Coaches, were invited to complete a self-assessment tool based on several success factors to identify key focus areas that should be considered in order to be successful. This webinar provided grantees the opportunity to review the results of this assessment and discuss how they plan to adjust or update their implementation plans to meet current industry needs. Three America's Promise grantees shared their experiences with identifying challenges and implementing changes to overcome those challenges to meet grant goals.

Bruce Rankin, TA Coach, shared an overview of the self-assessment process and provided a high-level analysis of the quantitative and qualitative results of the assessment tool.

Greg Goloborodko, Senior Project Manager from Worksystems Inc., provided insight on how his program made changes to align the current program design to increase degree and credential attainment by adding shorter-term trainings.

Lexi Mason, Outreach Specialist and Project Lead from City of Springfield, MO, addressed how her program was able to add new short-term programs to make up for a projected shortfall in program participants and training completions.

Gary Sulski, IT Sector Strategy Program Manager from Brevard Workforce Development Board, Inc., shared how his program was able to create better inter-staff engagement through role playing and an improved intake process.

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
